

Bhorajguda Oorani

Bhorajguda village is situated in Inderveli Mandal of Adilabad district in Andhra Pradesh. The work planned in this village was the creation of a new Oorani, construction of surplus weir, fencing and introduction of bio sand filters. The earth work for storage of water could not be done as they hit a rocky layer. They had to go for blasting and then removal of the rocks through machinery as only a small portion could be done through human labour. The expenditure increased due to this reason. So the villagers have decided to complete the removal of rocks in the first phase and take up the remaining works in the second phase.

Additional funds are needed for the second phase to complete the surplus weir construction, fencing and biosand filters. A request has been made to Anand Charity to consider support for the second phase as well. There was not much scope for contribution through labour in the work done so far. So the villagers have requested for 15% contribution in first phase but will contribute 25% overall in the two phase together. The removal of rocks using machinery has been completed. Presently there is seven feet water in the oorani.
