I am R.Banumathi from Avchipatti Village. My husband is a farmer. We have one daughter. My husband has 2 brothers and those two brothers have sons. My husband has some ancestors properties, however, my husband family refused to give share of the properties since we don't have sons. We don't know, whether my family has rights to claim the rights for the properties. My husband is not giving importance to approach advocate and take initiatives to get our rights.

*I heard about that, on 05.12.2016, there is a Free Legal Consultation Programme through Video Conference in our village Community Resource Center. I want to get support of the free service and hence, I went to the Community Resource Center. I have consulted with Advocate Mr.Ravichandran through Video Conference and explained about my family situation. He insisted that, though we have only daughter, we have rights on the ancestor properties and the rights can be claimed through a legal case. He pointed out that way of filing the case and fees on court, etc in detail manner. I feel very easy to get consult with the lawyer over video conference and feel very useful. **My interaction on that videoconference increases my confidence level to get our family rights.***

After the Video conference, I informed to my husband and we approached to the advocate. He guides us to get the case file with very low cost. Now, my husband brothers are coming forward to discuss with us and sorted out our property dispute.
